Description

The documentation (e.g. http://www.gromacs.org/Documentation/Gromacs_Uilities/g_spatial) usually contains links to the online manual, all of which (as far as I can tell) point to a location which returns a 404 error page: http://www.gromacs.org/Documentation/Gromacs_Uilities/g_spatial. This should point to <http://manual.gromacs.org/programs/gmx-spatial.html> or be removed entirely.
